TIMELINE for Statutory Assessment



Parent, School or another Professional requests Statutory Assessment EA decide within 6 weeks if they are going to do an educational Assessment.

6 weeks

EA sends parent a notice of consideration (usually within 10 days)

Period of 22 days within which parent can provide written evidence to the EA.

Still part of the 6 weeks

If EA decides to do a Statutory Assessment

EA has 10 weeks to complete the Assessment.

6+10 = 16 weeks = **4 months**

If EA decide **NOT** to do an assessment parents have 2 months to appeal

When Assessment is completed EA considers if a Statement is needed

EA has 2 weeks to decide if they will issue a Statement.

16 weeks +2 weeks = **4.5 months**

Time Limit for carrying out Assessments & proposed Statements

It should take no longer than 18 weeks to issue a proposed Statement, from the date of either the EA receiving the request or the issue of the notice under Article15(1) whichever is appropriate.

Total 18 weeks = 4.5 months

EA sends proposed Statement & invites parents to send Representations/comments Parents should send comments within 15 days.

EA has 8 weeks to consider parents comments before finalising the Statement.

18 weeks + 6 weeks =26 weeks = **6.5 months**
